- ART's & Profile's co-production of *Indecent* opened on Saturday, February 22, at Lincoln Hall (read the Willamette Week <u>review</u>). A number of performances are approaching sold-out status. *Indecent* runs through March 8.
- Portland Actors Conservatory's production of *Never in My Lifetime* opened on February 21 at Lincoln Hall Studio and runs through March 1.
- ART EDU is beginning its residency program at Vancouver School of Arts and Academics. Resident
  Artists Sarah Lucht, Michael Mendelson, Chris Harder, EM Lewis, Barbie Wu, and Guest Teaching Artist
  Lynda Hayden will be providing workshops and classes in playwriting, Shakespeare, Meisner, clowning
  and movement, and acting styles.

  Festival.
