Highlights

- ART's virtual release party of Magellanica, the Audio Drama, is on Sunday, September 27, at 2pm. From
 the comfort of home, participants will tune into all five parts of E.M. Lewis's Antarctic epic drama full of
 adventure, romance, science, history, and music! They'll also enjoy small group discussions with the cast
